If you have an Aloha Pacific FCU or Hawaii National Guard CU credit card, you can conveniently alert us about your travel schedule through our card management site, *gotomycard.com*.

That way we'll automatically know that your card is not being used fraudulently in an unusual location.

First, you must have registered your

card at *gotomycard.com* at least 30 days before this function is effective.

- Sign in to your account.
- On the icons page, click on Customer Service.
- Click on *Set a travel notification*.
- Next, set the *Travel Start Date* and the *Travel End Date*.
- Click on Send.
