SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION NOW ONLINE

Apply now for Aloha Pacific FCU's Masami Oishi Memorial Scholarships. Fifteen APFCU members will each receive \$2,000 this summer.

This is the 30^{th} year of the scholarships, named after APFCU's first manager and president/CEO.

Go to *alohapacific.com* to download and fill in the application. The completed application, including official transcripts, a letter of intent and a resume, must be postmarked no later than Monday, April 24.

Important: Please note that the transcripts must be official, not photocopied or downloaded by applicants. These usually are generated by admissions offices and sealed, often featuring a raised stamp of the school or other security elements. If you have questions about what is official or not official, ask your admissions office for details. Unofficial transcripts will disqualify your application.

Awards are based on financial need, community service and academic achievement.

Eligibility requirements include:

- APFCU membership in good standing: at least \$5 in your savings account and no loan delinquencies for at least one year prior to July 5, 2017
- Enrollment full time in an accredited program, such as an associate, baccalaureate or graduate degree

Recipients must be available the week of July 10–14 for picture-taking and to pick up their awards.

Some restrictions apply. See scholarship application for details. Scholarship awards are restricted to one award per member per lifetime so that we may assist as many members as possible.
